### ACCESSIBILITY

### PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION

#### MIAMI PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

- Metrorail's Orange Line services between Miami International Airport and the University of Miami's "University" stop. The cost is \$2.25 and can be paid for by contactless payment, EASY Card, EASY ticket, or the GO Miami-Dade Transit app. Trains operate from 5am-12a, and run every 10 minutes during peak (rush) hours, every 15 minutes during non-peak hours until 8p, then every 30 minutes.

#### RIDE SHARE / TAXI

- If using a ride share or taxi, helpful addresses include:

  - **Ungar Building**, 1365 Memorial Dr, Coral Gables, FL 33146 for conference programming

#### PARKING:
